REMINDER FOR A1 STUDENTS AND PARENTS/CARERS

Multi-factor authentication

Can I remind A1 students that they are required to download and sign up to the official Microsoft Multi-Factor Authenticator App.

A1s must have the authenticator in order to access resources outside College. The deadline date for registration is **Monday, 17 June**.

There are around 600 students who have yet to sign up.

Multi-Factor Authentication for Students

Starting from **June 3 2024**, A1 students will be required to download and sign up to the Official Microsoft Multi-Factor Authenticator App. **This does not affect A2 students.**

Students must have the authenticator in order to access college resources outside of College.
